Metrorail: Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) continues right on track with construction of the AirportLink, a 2.4-mile Metrorail extension going from the existing Earlington Heights Station to the Miami Intermodal Center (MIC), a transportation hub being built next to Miami International Airport (MIA). The \$506 million project, which is now nearing 80% completion, is scheduled to open in spring 2012.

The AirportLink and the new MIA Metrorail station will offer a convenient way for millions of local residents and tourists to travel to and from MIA every year. In addition, the new extension will make it easier for residents, from as far south as Florida City or the Upper Florida Keys, and from as far north as Broward County, to commute to one of the County's major employers, MIA, via Metrorail and its connecting bus routes.
